We are so grateful for your help and support. Your child really thrives on your praise at the end of a school day when they tell you what reward they have earned that day – thank you!

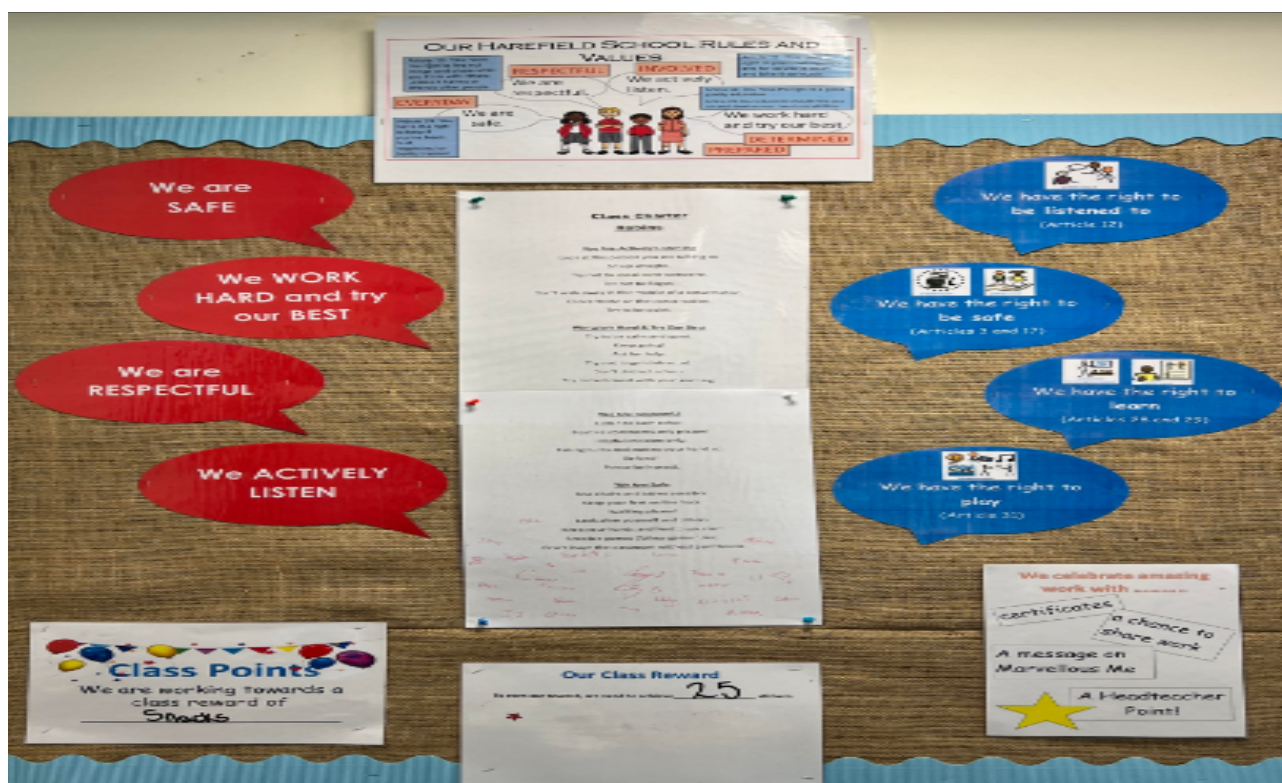
At Harefield Primary we all strive to follow our school **PRIDE** values:
