Reception pupils will be split into two groups based on their birthday.

Children Born Between Sept 1st and February 28th Start on 7th September;

Monday and Tuesday 8.40am -11.30am

Wednesday and Thursday 8.40am -12.30pm

Friday 8.40am -3.15pm

Your child will be expected to be in school full time (8.40am -3.15pm) from Friday 11th September

Children Born Between March 1st and August 31st Start on 10th September;

Thursday and Friday 8.40-11.30

Monday and Tuesday 8.40-12.30

Wednesday 8.40-3.15

Your child will be expected to be in school full time (8.40am -3.15pm) from Wednesday 16th September

School Lunches - [Harefield Primary School - School Lunches](#)

What you need to know about school lunches:

- Every child in Year R, 1 and 2 is entitled to a free school lunch every day
- Lunches are free for children in receipt of free school meals in years 3–6
- Meals for children in years 3–6 not eligible for free school meals cost **£3** per day
