Now let's learn 'Please'. In English letters it's *law samaht*. In Arabic letters it's *لو سمحت*

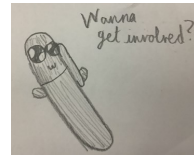
Now let's do 'Yes'. In English letters it's *ah*. In Arabic letters it's *نعم*

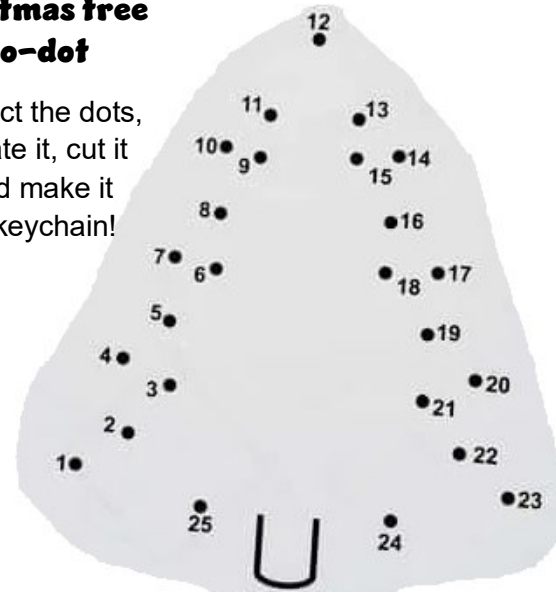

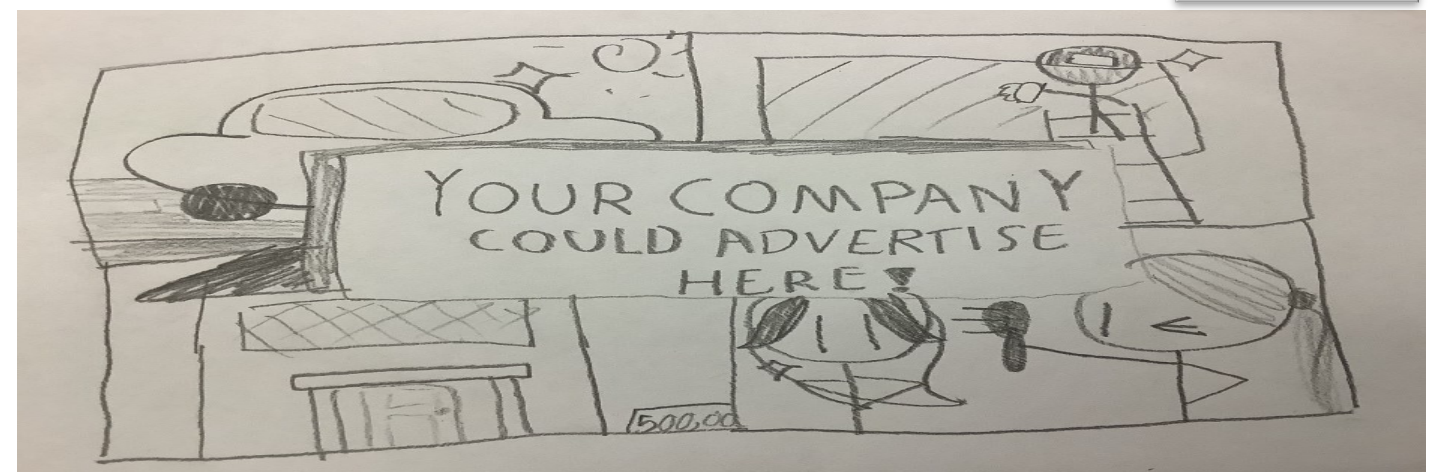

Recently a survey went to all parents about school lunches. If **you have opinions on what would improve the dinners, tell your parents today!**







Kate's lunch opinion

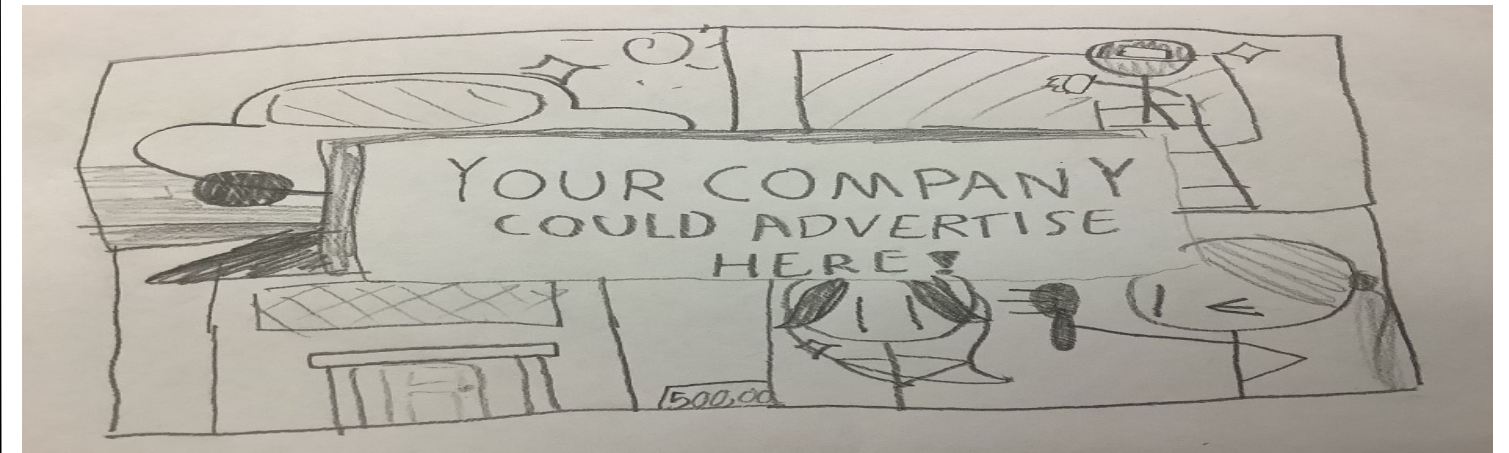

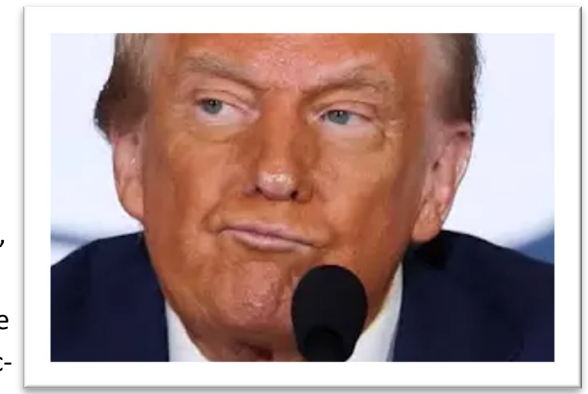
